WYNNUM OPEN CUP (WOMEN'S HB) CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- Individual Event: The Championship will be a Stroke Handicap event over 18 holes.
- There is to be only one Wynnum Open Cup winner regardless of grade
- Eligible players are female golfers with a current GA handicap and must be a current financial member of recognised Golf Club, excluding Visiting Professional Golfers and PGA Honorary Members (Refer to PGA Member Policy), Members of golf clubs without a golf course or online golf clubs such SGA, Future Golf, GenY may play on the day, but are not eligible to be the Honour Board winner.
- Maximum Daily handicap for the event is 45. (Players with a handicap more than 45 are still eligible but must play with a handicap of 45).
- In the event of a tie, the winner will be determined by Count-Back (default method as per GA).
- The Championship will be played from the Red Tees.
- The local rules for the day will apply and are to be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf.
- It is the player's responsibility to be familiar with the Conditions of Play.
- The trophy presentation will be held at the Club immediately following the conclusion of play and prizes awarded on the day will include but not limited to the following:
 - 18 hole Overall Nett Winner
 - 18 hole Overall Nett runner up
 - 18 hole Division Gross Winners
 - 18 hole Division Nett Winners
- All players will play to the Wynnum Course Playing Handicap. The following Divisions (Playing Handicaps) apply: Division 1: 0-22, Division 2: 23-32, Division 3: 33-45.
- Players may use motorised carts subject to availability.
- The cost is \$15 per player.
- The Club Match Committee shall have sole management and control of the competition with full power at any time to alter or vary any of the conditions in very exceptional circumstances. All disputes will be referred to the Match Committee in writing no more than 15 minutes after the completion of Play. Match Committee decisions in these matters are final.
